



I n s t r u c t o r O b j e c t i v e s

The successful instructor at the Center for Biblical Studies will demonstrate his/her ability to:

1. Manufacture a faculty-approved syllabus.
2. Construct student-oriented lesson objectives and learning outcomes.
3. Delimit the course's scope and sequence.
4. Prepare a course calendar congruent with the audience's needs and course descriptors.
5. Identify a faculty-approved textbook(s) that is (are) under \$20.
6. Arouse student interest and curiosity during the introduction of each lesson.
7. Employ a problem or question to relate the lesson objectives to the student's needs.
8. Create and follow a unified lesson outline with smooth transitions and flow.
9. Exhort the students to apply the lesson's solution or answer.
10. Produce an appropriate overall affective or emotional response to the lesson.
11. Assess the student's performance of the lesson's objectives and outcomes.
12. Speak with clear enunciation and with varying speed, volume, and pitch.
13. Speak with appropriate and congruent non-verbal gestures and mannerisms.
14. Respond respectfully and appropriately to student questions and comments.
15. Encourage and control student participation and discussion.
16. Use pedagogical techniques that are appropriate to the subject matter.
17. Control class time effectively.
18. Use appropriate and congruent supporting materials and resources, e.g. A/V, handouts, etc.
19. Collect, record, and submit grades and attendance in a timely fashion.
