Include the following in your bio:

### **PERSONAL: Describe yourself.**

- Where are you from?
- Tell us about your family, e.g. married/single, children, their ages, etc.
- What are your hobbies/interests?
- Tell us something unusual about yourself that most people don't know.

### **EDUCATION/VOCATIONAL TRACK: Describe your credentials.**

- Where did you receive your under-graduate degree?
- What is your degree program and track at DTS?
- What do you hope or expect to do vocationally after Seminary?
- How do expect CBS to prepare you for ministry?

### **PART YOU PLAY AT CBS: Describe your course and its benefits to your students.**

- Tell us about your previous CBS experience: student or instructor.
- What are your thoughts about the subject matter you will be teaching?
- What do you hope your students will gain from your teaching at CBS?
