Extension students who have not completed ST101 Introduction to Theology must contact the Registrar's Office by phone (800.992.0998, x3609) in order to register for ST102-106. Web registration is disallowed due to prerequisite requirements.
3. Th.M. and M.A.C.E. students (Houston) need to take four semesters of Spiritual Formation in a small group setting. Weekly meetings are arranged with an advisor at a time mutually agreed on by the group.
