DTS 2021 Evacuation Drills

An unannounced evacuation drill for the **Dallas campus** was held on December 16, 2021 between 8:30am and 10:10am. The alarms were sounded in one building at a time and occupants were required to evacuate the buildings. Most of the alarm systems worked as designed. We found that the alarm system for the Mitchell/Book Store buildings had been silenced and the horn strobes were disabled and it was reset. We talked about reminding everyone where their muster points are and staying at least 50 feet away from the buildings. A successful test of the DTS alert system was conducted on 01/12/2022.

The annual fire/evacuation drill for the **DTS-Washington DC** campus was completed on October 23, 2021 during classes at Burke Community Church, 9900 Old Keene Mill Road, Burke, Virginia 22015. We evacuated two classrooms of students, faculty and staff for a total of 12 people. Staff members checked the bathrooms and we all met in the far parking lot in 2min 30sec. We received excellent cooperation for this exercise from students and faculty. The drill was unannounced.

On Friday, December 3, 2021 the **Atlanta Extension** of Dallas Theological Seminary at North Point Community Church conducted an announced emergency evacuation drill. Jake Gross, Dean of DTS-Atlanta, conducted the drill. The following was identified:

- Smoke detectors and fire suppression sprinkler systems were observed in the classroom space and throughout the facility.
- Egress from the classroom space to building exterior took less than 35 seconds upon sounding the alarm. Egress was conducted walking at a normal, unhurried, pace.
- A safe gathering spot for evacuees to gather outside the building was identified. The location is the second tier of the parking lot, directly out the egress door of the building.

On Wednesday, December 15, 2021 the Atlanta Extension of Dallas Theological Seminary at Passion City Church conducted an announced emergency evacuation drill. Jake Gross, Dean of DTS-Atlanta, conducted the drill. The following was identified:

- Smoke detectors and fire suppression sprinkler systems were observed in the classroom space and throughout the facility.
- Egress from the classroom space to building exterior took 41 seconds upon sounding the alarm. Egress was conducted walking at a normal, unhurried, pace.
- A safe gathering spot for evacuees to gather outside the building was identified. The location is the parking lot, directly outside the egress door of the building.
